Summer Assignment After reading the book, choose ONE of the following assignments:

1) Write a friendly letter to the author of your book. Your letter should include a brief introduction of yourself, your reason for writing the letter, and the book's title. You should also briefly describe what you liked best about the novel using details from the book for support. Finally, you should include any other information about the book that will enhance your letter and thank the author for reading your letter.

2) Design a poster to advertise your book to other readers. Use lots of colourful adjectives to capture the reader's interest. Be sure to include the story elements -such as the title, the author's name, the setting, the conflict, the goal and the resolution of the story. Finally, write a short summary of the book's main events/plots of the story.

2) Essay: Write an expository essay based on the following question:

How does the power of the female characters in *Little Women* compare to the power of the male characters? Ensure you follow the structure of an expository essay with an adequate thesis statement, introductory paragraph, body paragraphs, and a concluding paragraph.
